Last week, we learned the importance and the steps of brushing teeth. We identified the letter F and its sound /f/.



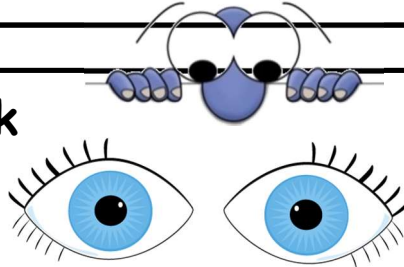
EYE EXAM FREQUENCY

- Write letter (F,f) between the top, middle, and bottom lines.





- **Line:** Sketch oblique lines.
- **Color:** Identify things that are blue.

- **Number:** Trace number 3.
- **Pattern:** Identify the AAB pattern.
